A PIT Count is designed to track the level of homelessness in a community. The goal of this count is to gain a clear picture of the trends in homelessness in Saskatoon, in conjunction with other counts happening across Canada. Individuals & families who are homeless on the street, in shelters, in inappropriate accommodations and those who are at-risk of imminent homelessness.
